### 3 CHAIRMAN

A successful meeting with FBC had been held on 6 January, preliminary to change of airfield ownership on 1 Apr 15, during which the key business parameters of PNGC were set out to senior management. A follow-up meeting was held on 16 Jan, which included HCA, with a number of new challenges identified by the latter. The issues are complex and being worked through by DD and TW.

RCAM reports submitting its plans to the CAA for airfield registration. These remain opaque to tenants, while the likely costs and risks have been flagged to FBC in context of no new aviation tenants having yet been identified to PNGC. This is a major future cost-driver for PNGC.
