NOTES:

- 1 One of the buggies has a damaged drive system, the exact failure is under investigation. The most likely cause is continued use to pull heavy glassfibre 2 seat gliders. The duty instructors need to “buy in” to only using tractors for K21’s and the Duo and actively recall buggies that go to get these aircraft. This includes towing out in the morning.
- 2 The ongoing lack of power and light in the hanger is preventing progress on a number of projects. This need to be addressed urgently.
- 3 Suitable replacements for the RangeRovers can be obtained for around £1000 (with MOT).
- 4 The main Avgas bowser is seldom run long enough or at sufficient rev to keep the batteries charged. On average I am charging the batteries about every 6 weeks. A possible solution is to install a pair of solar trickle chargers on the cab roof. Estimated cost £300.
- 5 There are battery charging with other vehicles as well. One solution being considered is to fit them with permanent trickle chargers and simply to plug them in when they are parked up in the hanger at the end of each day. Estimated cost £20 per vehicle.
